

SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

If you have not made a Will and would like to leave a gift to Variety, the Children's Charity, here is some suggested wording. We encourage you to see your solicitor or Will writer.

Residuary Bequests

(a remainder of the estate after all other gifts and debts have been paid)

Subject to the payment of my debts, funeral and testamentary expenses, I give the whole / _____% (delete/complete as appropriate) of my estate not otherwise disposed of by my Will to Variety, the Children's Charity, Registered Charity No. 209259 (England & Wales) and SC038505 (Scotland) of Variety House, 93 Bayham Street, London NW1 0AG for the general purposes of Variety, the Children's Charity and I declare that the receipt by its Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

Pecuniary Bequests

(a fixed amount of money)

Specific Bequest (a specific piece of property, a piece of artwork for example)
